



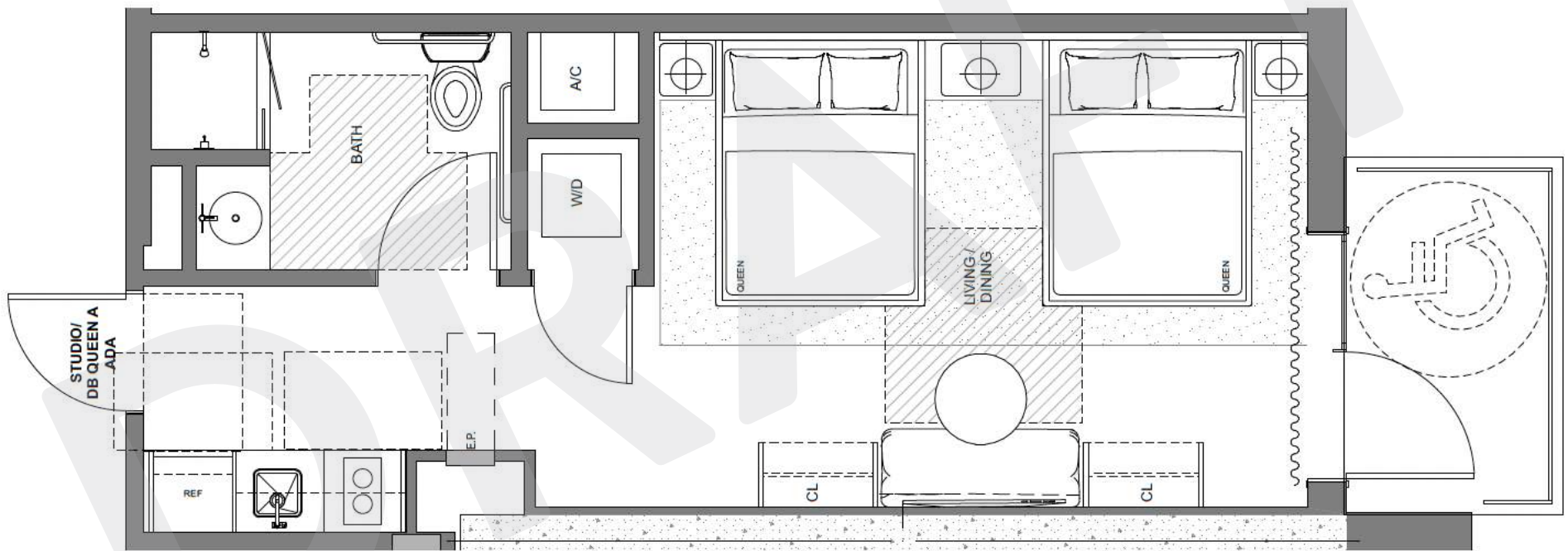

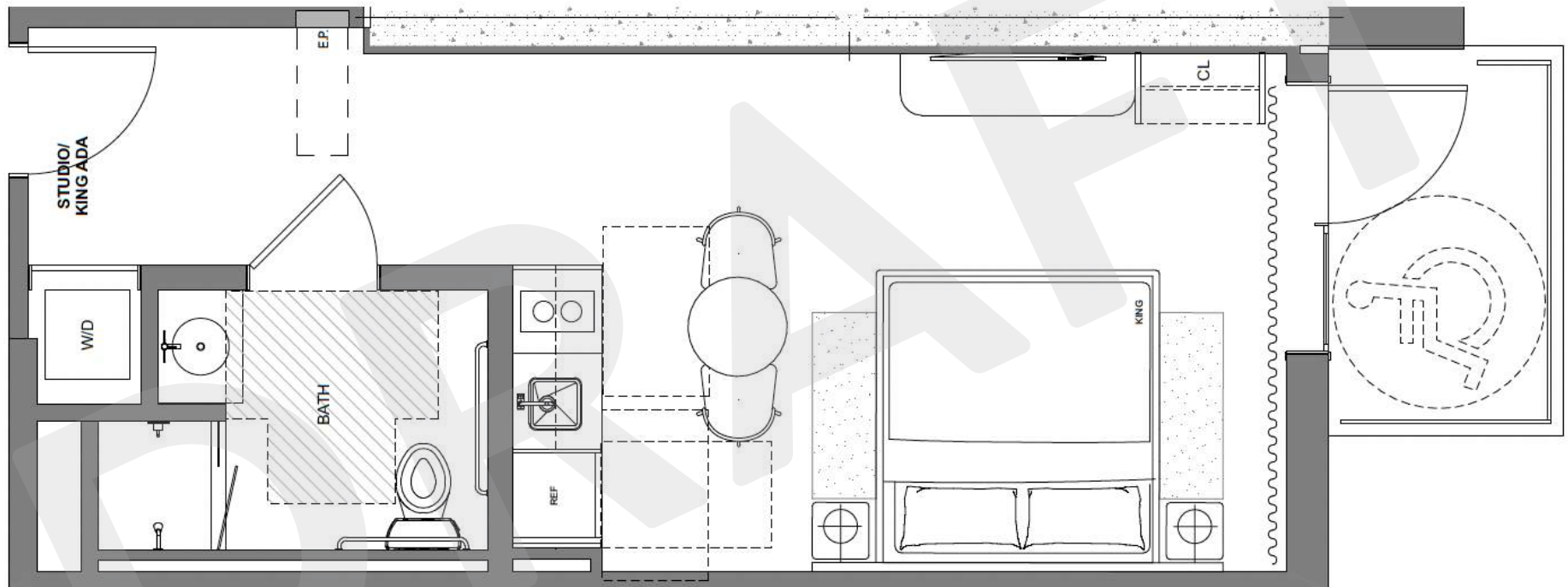

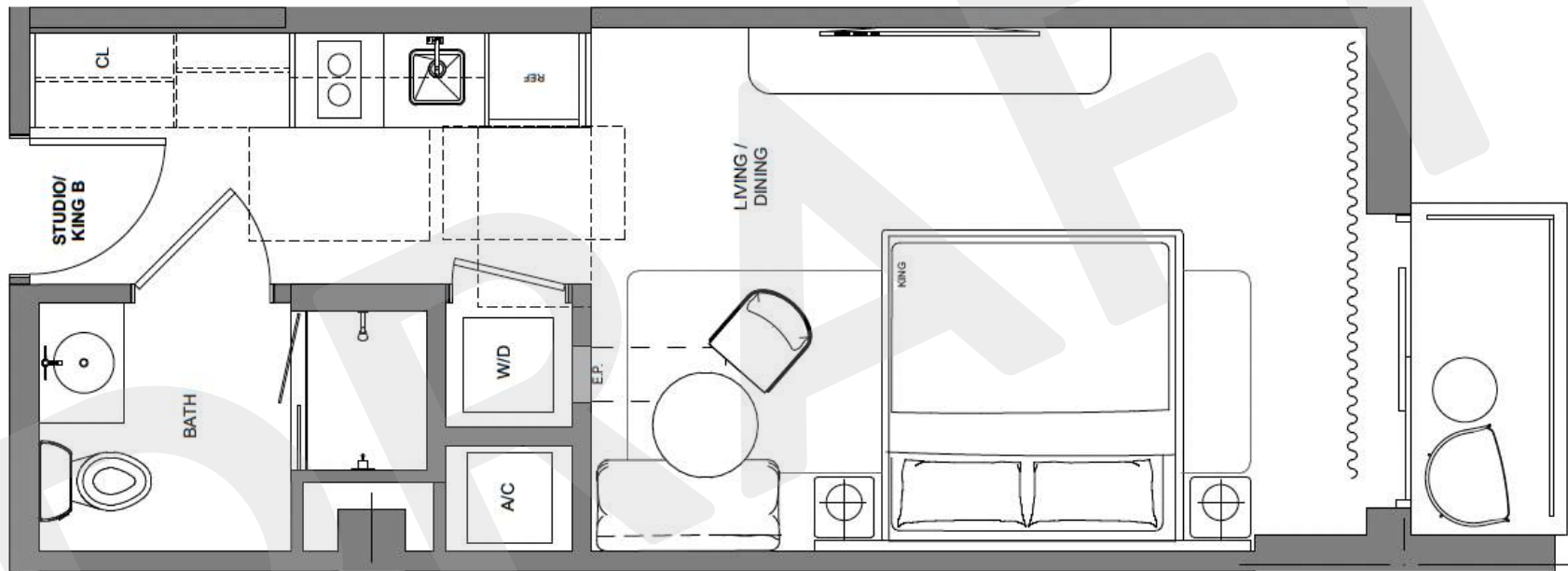


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STUDIO - KING B LINES: 11, 12, 13, 14, 18

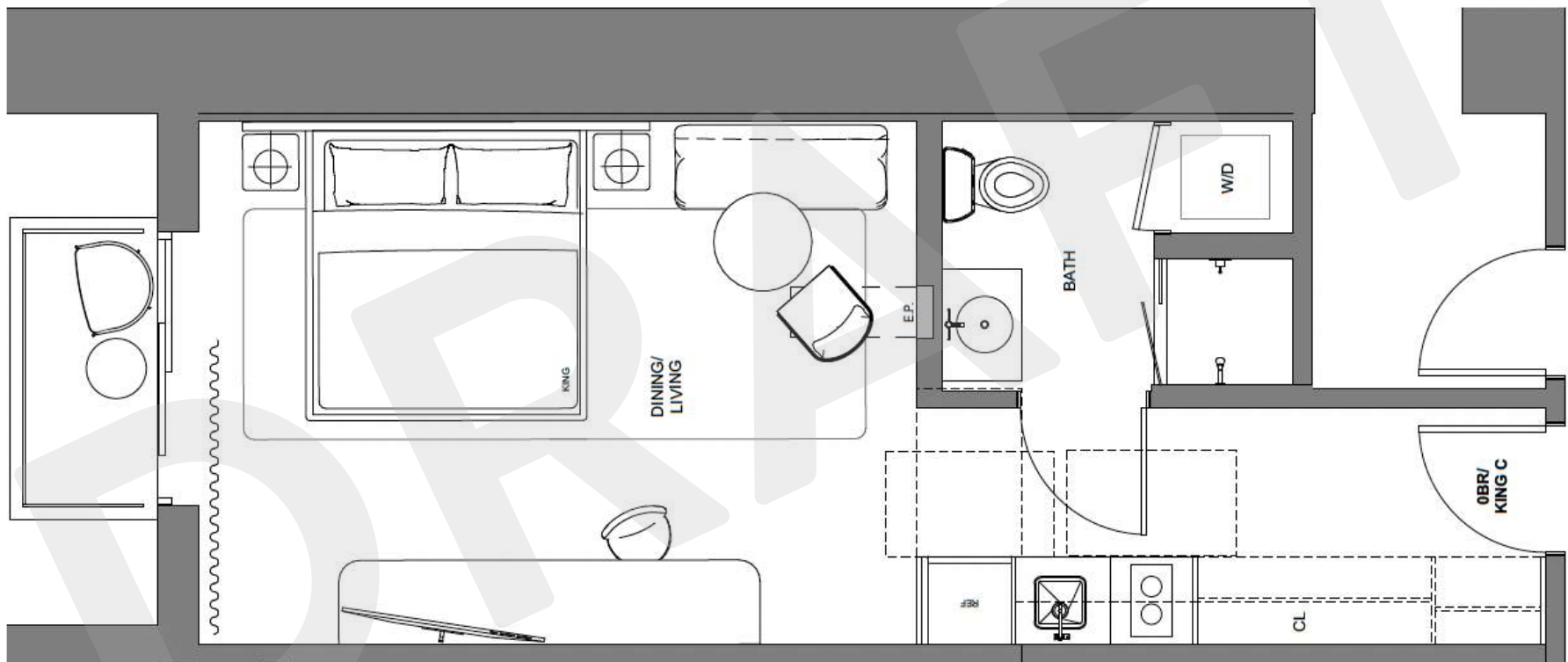


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STUDIO - KING C LINE 19

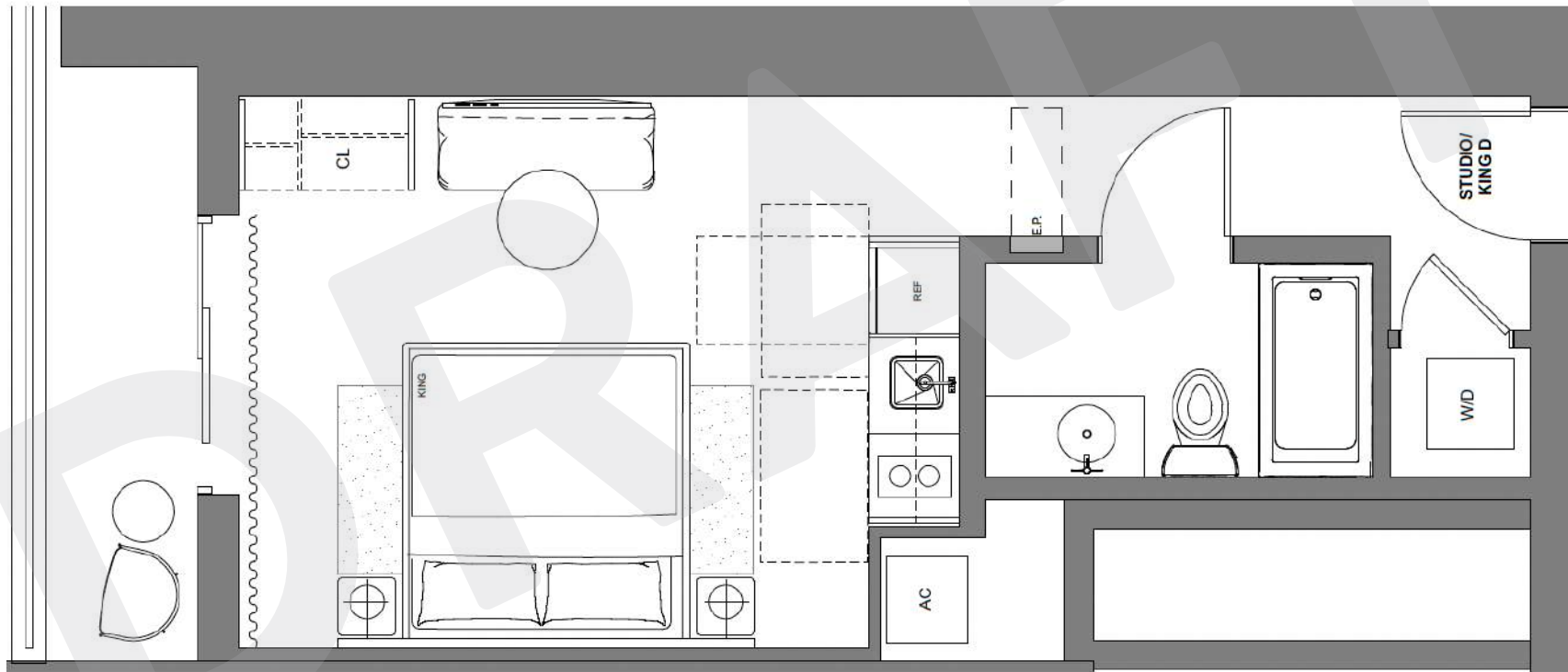


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STUDIO - KING D LINE 01

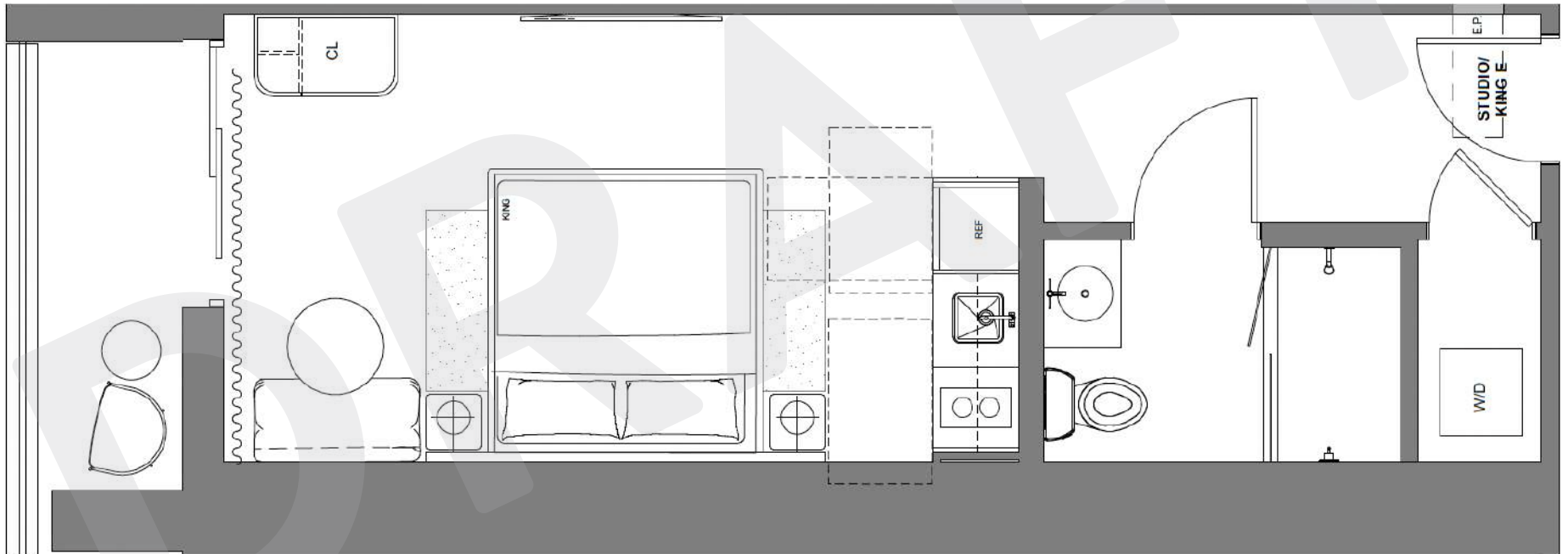


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STUDIO - KING E LINES: 02, 03

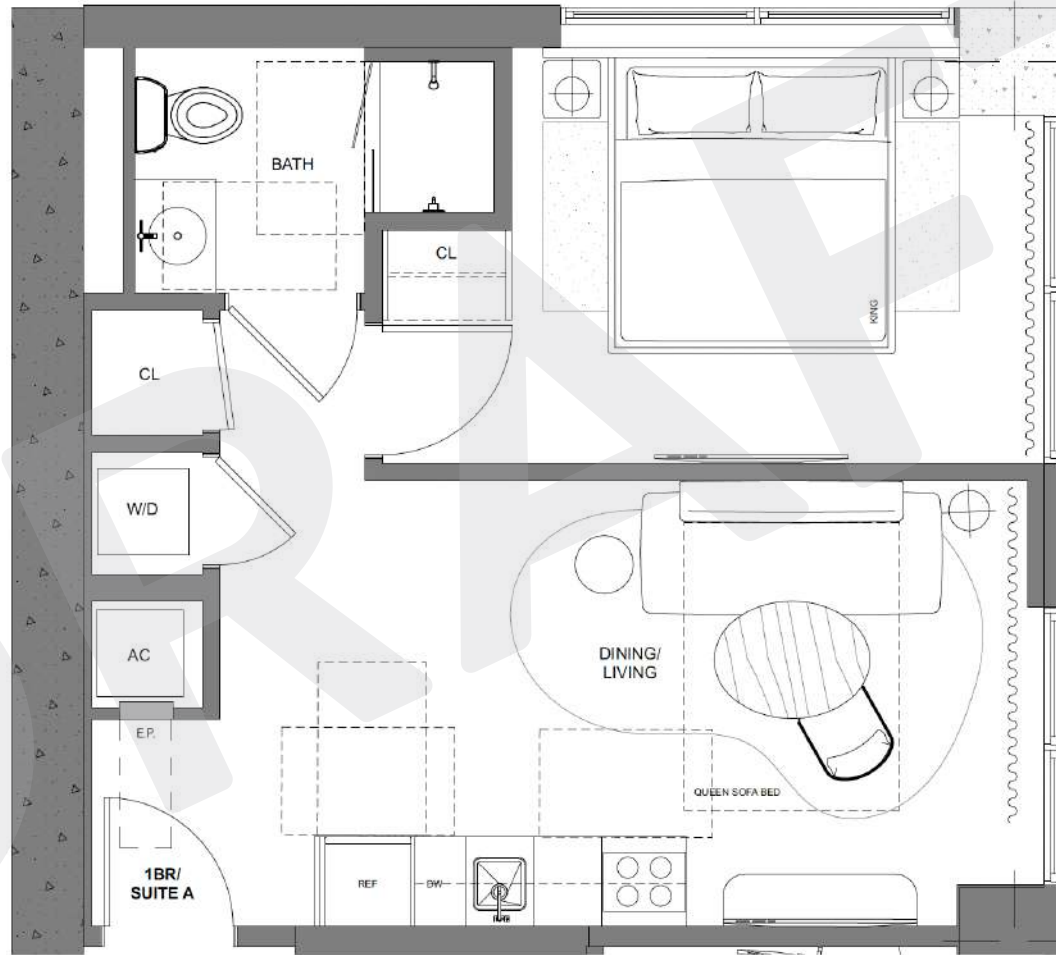


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1 BEDROOM - SUITE A LINE 04



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1 BEDROOM - SUITE A (ADA)

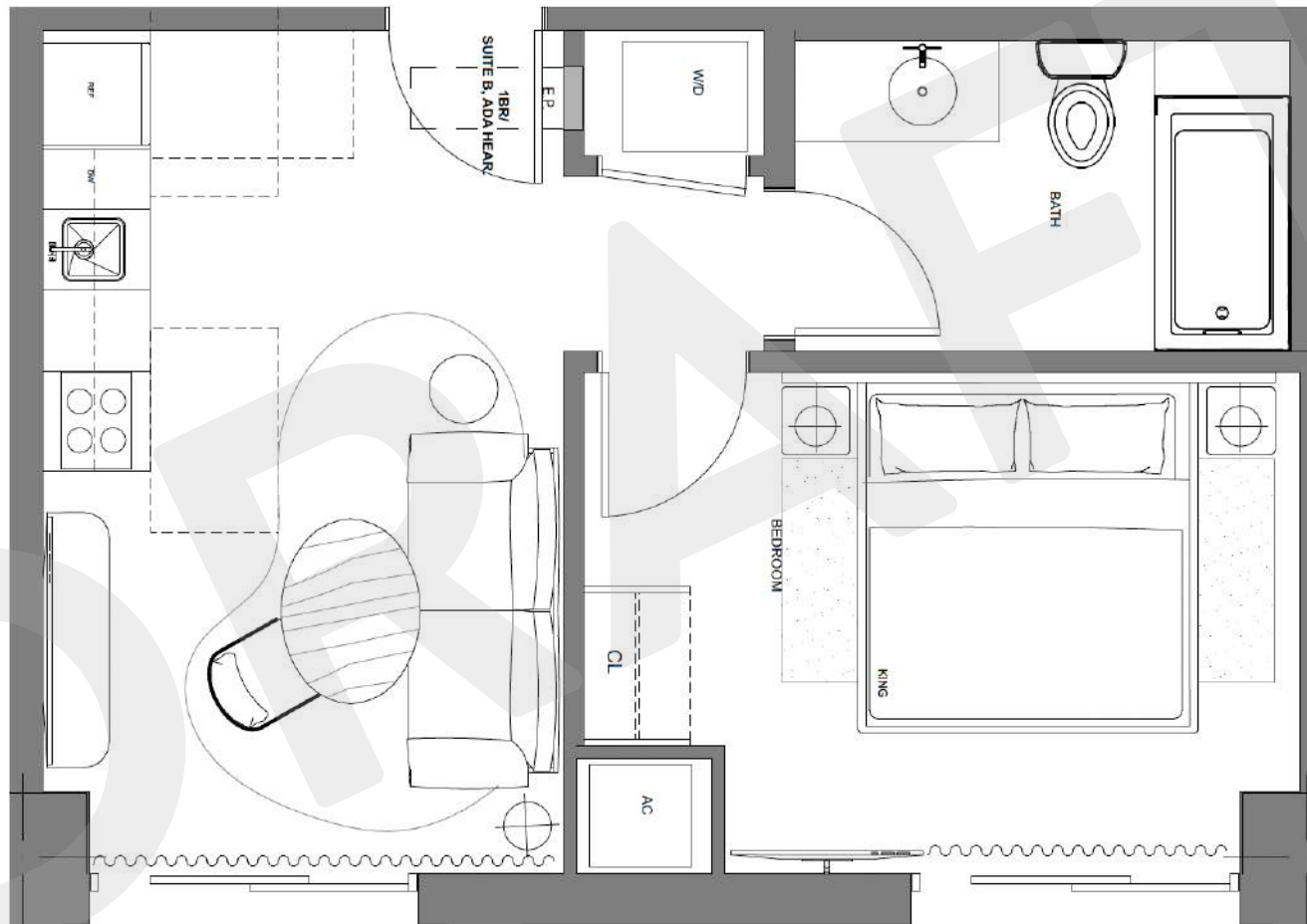


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1 BEDROOM - SUITE B LINE 05

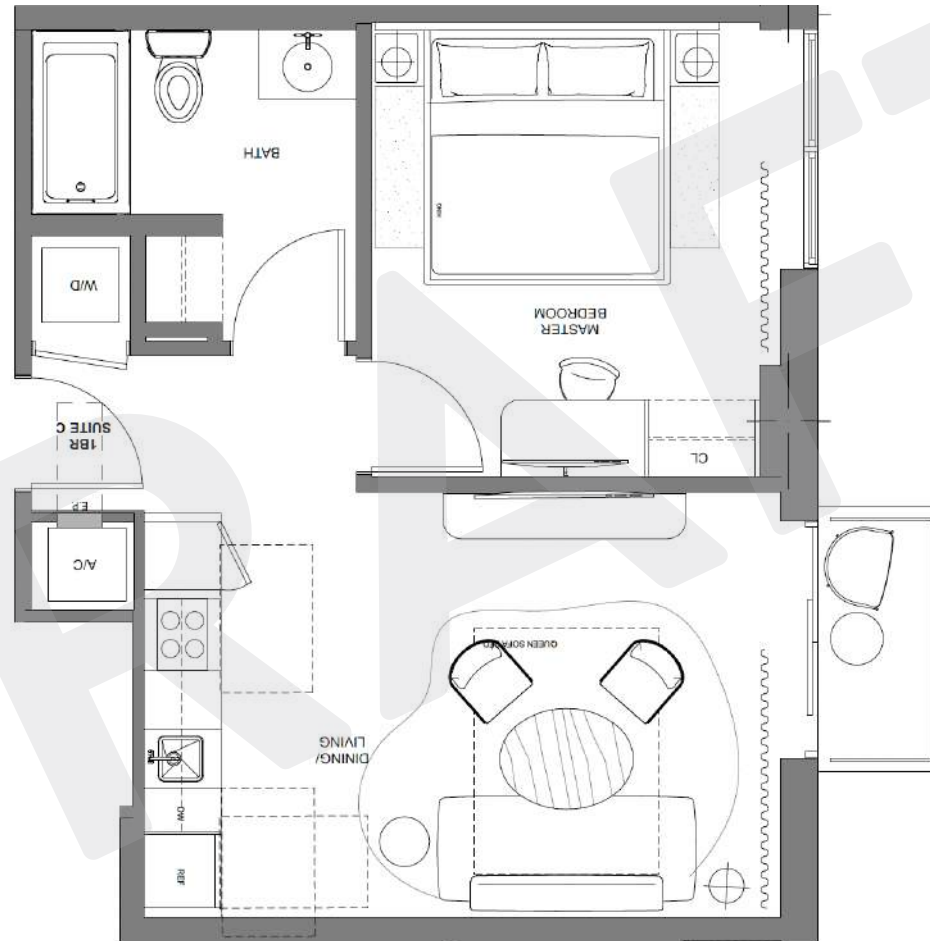


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1 BEDROOM - SUITE C LINE 16

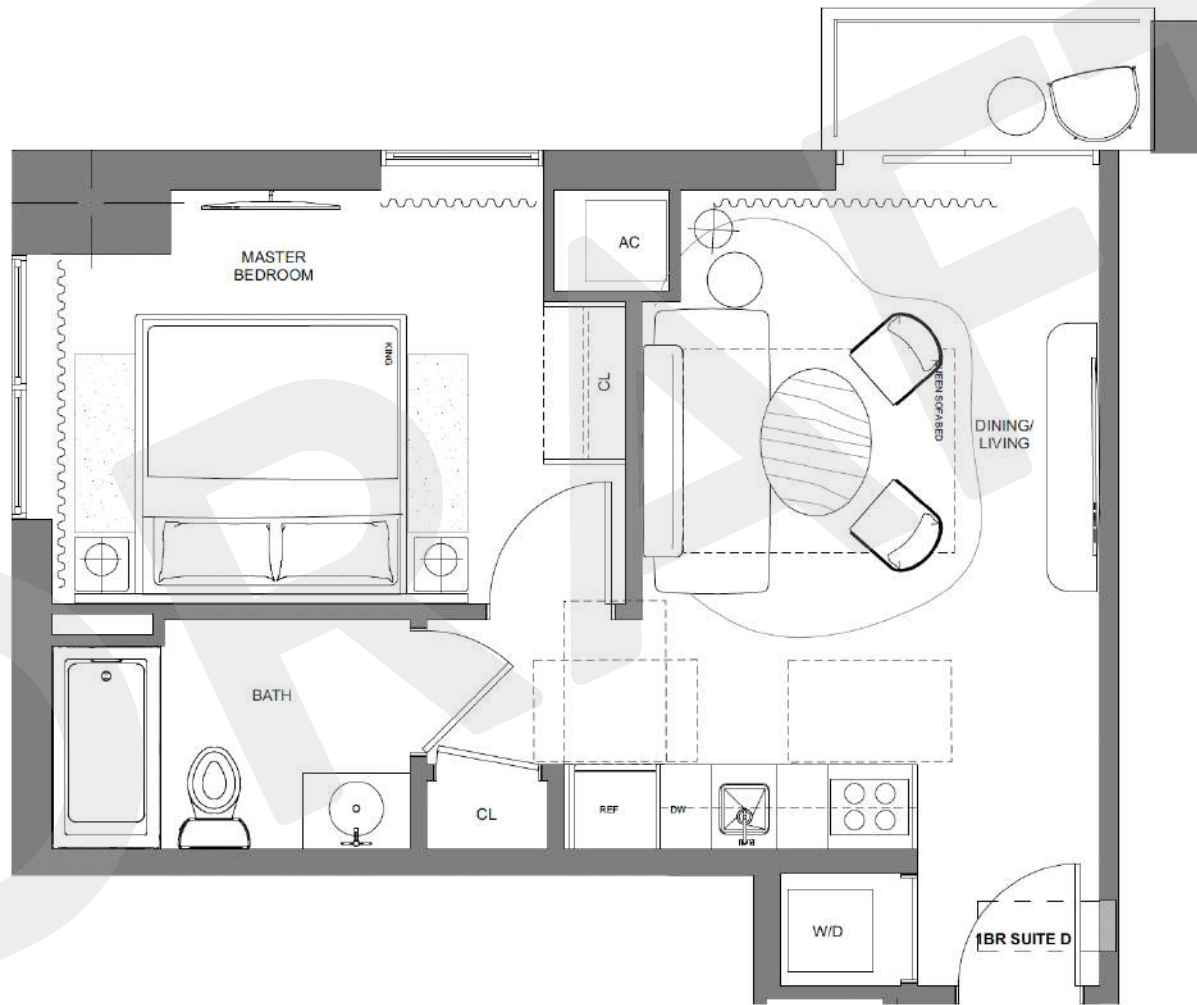


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1 BEDROOM - SUITE D LINE 17

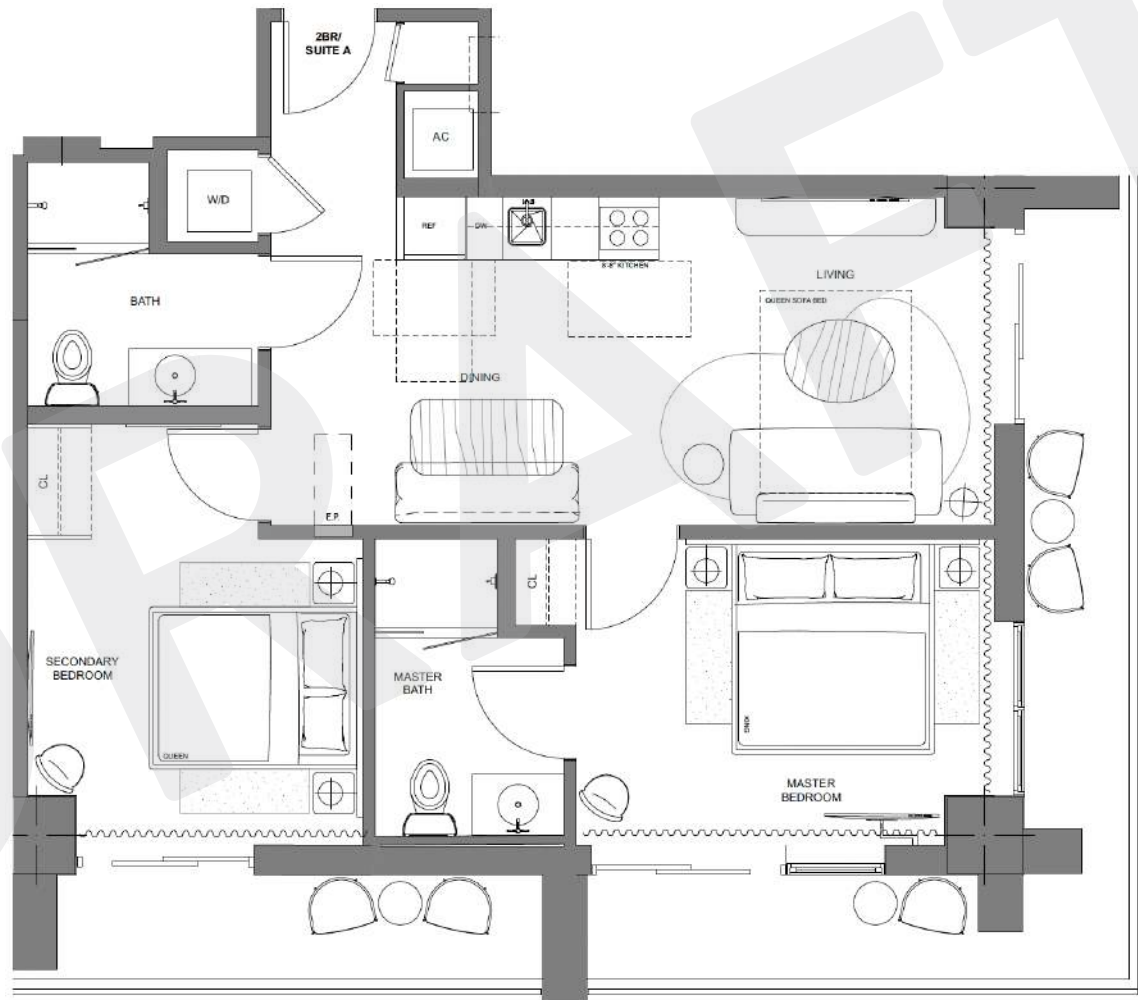


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2 BEDROOM - SUITE A LINE 06

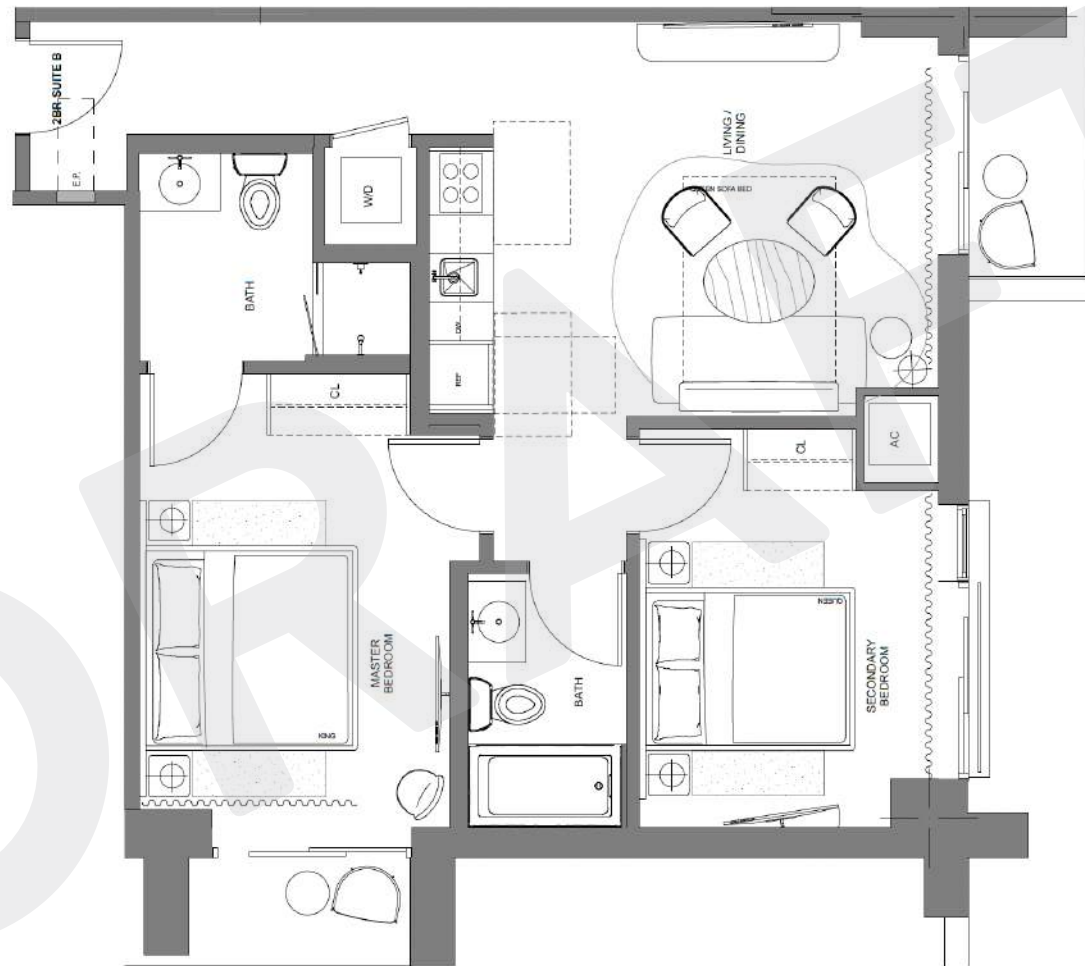


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2 BEDROOM - SUITE B LINE 15

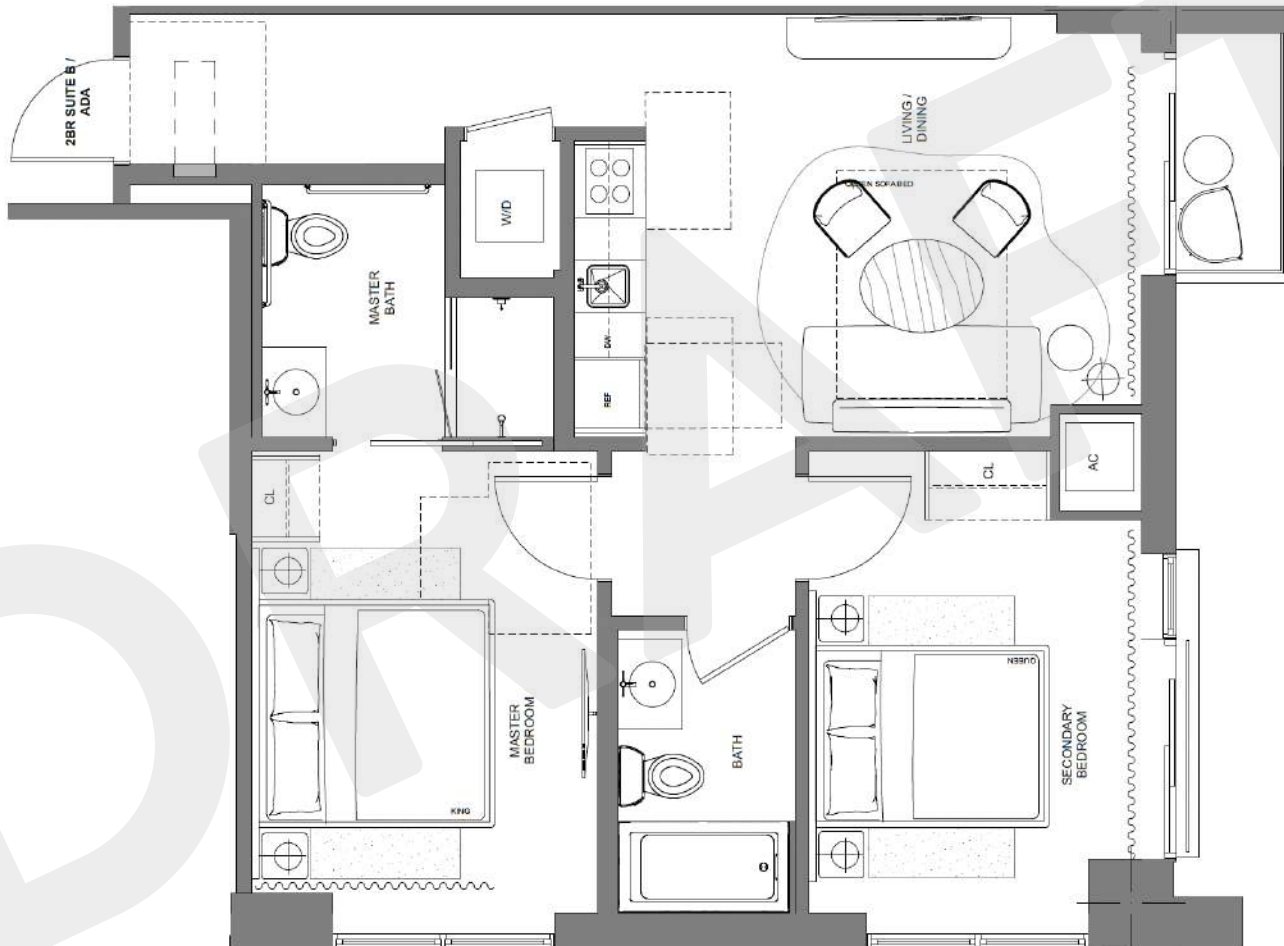


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2 BEDROOM - SUITE B (ADA)



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
